## Tedworth House Entrance Gates Project,

## South Tidworth, Wiltshire.

The origins of this fine old mansion are unclear but it was for many years a well known sporting estate, and at one time the home of the statesman Lord Broughton (1786 – 1869), when it was visited by the Duke of Wellington. Restructured and extended by John Johnson between 1878-1879 the house is now owned by the Ministry of Defence and is used as a personnel recovery centre for the 'Help for Heroes' charity.
